POLICIES 5776

YKP is a camp where fun and *chassidishkeit* mix – without compromise. While many outdoor camps are designed for talmidim who are holding at different levels of commitment, please be aware that YKP exists for the bochur who is interested and willing to put his all into *Torah and Chassidishkeit 24/7*. He will strive to uphold the highest standards of behavior, dress, and attitude at all times, even when it requires some *mesiras nefesh*, for instance, proper dress even in the heat. Therefore, the requirements listed on this contract are to be taken seriously by both talmid and parent. If you feel that you are not ready to observe them, please be honest with us and yourself. ואין מזרזין אלא למזרזין.

Trips	I understand that trips are dependent on <i>shmiras hasedorim</i> , davening, effort and performance. I understand that Test scores and/or effort will generally be used as a reflection of my effort. I know that participation in trips is not automatic, but is a privilege that must be earned by active involvement in the learning and <i>avodah</i> portion of the day.
Behavior	I will speak in manner befitting a Tamim. I understand that foul language will not be tolerated, even during casual conversation. I will show respect for the authority of the yeshiva staff, respect for my fellow bochurim and their possessions, and respect for all others with whom I come into contact at all times.
Electronics and Media	I understand I may bring ONLY Jewish reading material. I will not bring electronic devices with music video or internet capability (ipod, ipod touch, MP3 player, ipad, PSP, laptop, DVD players, etc.) I understand that if I do bring such items they will be confiscated and I may expect to be sent home. I will not bring knives, firecrackers, or other potentially hazardous material. If in doubt, I will ASK!!
Cell Phones	I understand that private cell phones are not permitted in YKP. If I am coming to Yeshivas Kayitz with a Cell phone, I will give my phone right away to my counselor. It will be returned before going home. Failure to do so can result in being sent home. All yeshiva staff members will have cell phones available for parents to call. There will also be an American line in the dormitory to use as needed.
Dress Code	I understand and agree to conform to the dress code: Black hat and proper blazer for davening (no casual jackets). Traditional Chabad wool Tzitzis. Dark colored pants and button-down white dress shirts for Tfilos and Sadorim. For trips and sports: T-shirts, casual pants, and sweatshirts. If they have writing or pictures they must be respectful and aidel. I agree not to bring: shorts, jeans, cotton or netted Tzitzis, sleeveless tops, and the like.
No Smoking Rule	I understand that there is zero tolerance for smoking at YKP and that smoking of any kind or any substance besides oxygen (hookah, cigars, cigarettes, pipes) will result in being sent home at my parent's' expense.
Valuables	If you have an item of importance such a camera, digital device, or money, you may give it to a counselor for safe-keeping, however, YKP takes no responsibility for valuable items. Be aware that our campus is serviced by various local workers.

**Deposit and
Refund**

\$300 damage deposit, paid at the time of tuition, will be returned at the sole discretion of YKP. If c"v the talmid is sent home, YKP will NOT refund the tuition balance. YKP may use the deposit funds to expedite his return ticket. In the event that a talmid does damage yeshiva property, regardless if intentional or accidental, fixing and/or replacing the damages will be deducted from the deposit funds. Damages that go unclaimed for will automatically be deducted from **all Talmidim deposits**. In the event that a Talmid needs to visit a doctor, the out of pocket fee will be taken from the deposit funds & the bill will be sent home. It is the parent's responsibility to contact the insurance company to be refunded for the Medical expenses.
